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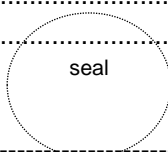

- 1) A letter of request/recommendation from the competent bishop/the person in charge of the episcopal conference (president or bishop in charge of major seminaries within the conference) or from the religious superior, specifying in a detailed manner the necessity of the planned course of study, and the – concrete – responsibilities the candidate will have on completion of his/her studies;
- 2) – ORDERS/CONGREGATIONS –: short description of the Province: history, present structure, priorities and challenges, including number of professed members, novices, postulants;
- 3) – CONGREGATIONS OF DIOCESAN RIGHT – letter of recommendation from the competent bishop;
- 4) If the scholarship candidate is destined, once his studies are completed, to work as a formator in a diocesan or national/regional major seminary: signed certifications from the bishop and the scholarship candidate (enclosures 1 and 2);
- 5) The curriculum vitae of the scholarship candidate including all the tasks and responsibilities assumed by him/her up to now, in a complete and chronological order;
- 6) Copies of the academic/ecclesiastical degrees earned so far by the scholarship candidate;
- 7) The certificate of registration or other certificate issued by the university/study institute confirming that the scholarship candidate has been accepted as a regular student;
- 8) Possibly copies of negative scholarship decisions of other organizations;
- 9) A copy of the identity card or passport showing the full name of the scholarship candidate.
